QUESTION:

Could you please provide a breakdown of infrastructure spending across each prison in the Northern Territory including Youth Justice facilities?

ANSWER:

During the reporting period, total infrastructure expenditure across correctional facilities was \$59,753,296. This includes costs associated with repairs and maintenance, as well as capital and minor works.

Expenditure by facility is outlined below:
