## Answer:

The Department of Land Resource Management incurred \$313 312 in consultancy costs in 2015-16 (to 31 March 2016) for 10 consultancies.

- a) No consultancies were associated with communications.
- b) One consultancy was over \$100 000:
  - Charles Darwin University Provision of a summary of research and other projects in all aspects of the mangrove environment of Darwin Harbour \$180 376
- c) The above consultancy was not conducted by an interstate company.

When procuring goods and services the Department of Land Resource Management complies with requirements under the *Procurement Act*, Regulations made under that Act, and Procurement Directions.

The Department had one consultancy valued over \$100 000 for the provision of a summary of research and other projects in all aspects of the mangrove environment of Darwin Harbour. This consultancy was put out to select tender due to the specialist nature of work required.
