Below is a brief description, .

ITEM DESCRIPTION		ESTIMATED VALUE
1-A.	The continuation of the existing After Hours Night Youth Patrol run by Alice Springs Town Council and Congress beyond September 2016.	
1-B.	The provision of an after-hours youth drop in centre for Alice Springs.	
2.	The upgrade of the Anzac Oval power to cater for recent infrastructure upgrades to the facility.	\$350,000
3.	A crematorium for Alice Springs as an adjunct to the role Alice Springs plays as the Central Australia health services centre.	\$500,000
4.	The construction of a community event centre/amphitheatre to cater for the growing demand for outdoor community entertainment events.	\$2M
