Question: How many cases of breach of bail have been recorded in Darwin, Palmerston and Alice Springs over the last 12 months?

Answer: Breach Bail Offences across the regions of Darwin and Casuarina combined, Palmerston¹, and Alice Springs² (and Northern Territory total), for two financial years to date (FYTD) and two periods of 12 months ending March 2017.
