Before your visit

- If you are making use of bus funding from Parliament (only available if you are including a voting session with NT Electoral Commission during your visit) please contact a **local bus company to request a quote**. Please advise the bus company that they will need to invoice us directly once the quote has been pre-approved by us.
Do not confirm your booking with the bus company unless you have received confirmation that we approve the quote.
- If you are travelling on your own bus there is no parking available at Parliament House. Instruct your driver to drop your group off at the end of Smith St near Civic Park, this is also the best location for pick up for your return to school.

During your visit

- **Punctuality is essential, please arrive five to ten minutes prior to your scheduled start time.** All visitors to Parliament House must pass through security screening on entry. This can take some time, especially for larger groups, so please consider this when planning your arrival.
- **Students are not permitted to bring bags to Parliament House.** Should you wish to bring a snack and water bottles these can be stored, but they'll need to be in insulated zipped bags for storage during your visit.
- **While the visit is led by Parliamentary educators, student supervision and behaviour management remains the responsibility of class teachers.**
- Program times vary, but usually will last two hours (tour and voting activity). A short break is provided in between sessions. Please factor in meeting time with your MLA if this has been arranged for you through PES – our team will advise if and when this will occur, if so generally this is at the conclusion of your visit.
