Answered On: 23/06/2004
Answer: \$900 000 has been allocated for the hospice for 2004-05. This is both for recurrent funding from its commencement in March 2005, and provides capacity to buy identified equipment and required furnishing.

A Clinical User Group is working up the details of what equipment and furnishing will be required to effectively run the hospice.

There has also been a lot of in-kind offers of donations from the public to provide things such as window furnishings, garden supplies, etc.
