Answer: Reported sexual assaults are recorded in the Police Real-time On-line

Management Information System (PROMIS) while Court proceedings are recorded in the Integrated Justice Information System (IJIS). As there is no link between the two systems it is not possible to definitely trace an individual incident report through the system to a resulting court

proceeding.

Conviction rate data is available from the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS). The Northern Territory's overall conviction rates for sexual assault

in 2002-03 and 2003-04 are the same at 67% - Refer Table 1.
