Answer: The total amount of money allocated to grants has been subject to CPI for some years and now totals \$255,000. \$200,000 is still the headline for physical conservation work to be carried out on privately owned places. Currently, the nominal allocation for the expenditure of the \$255,000 is \$200,000 for physical conservation, \$30,000 for festivals and events and \$25,000 for relief.
