Water and Sewerage in the Rural Area

In regard to water supply in the rural area, could the Minister advise on the following matters?

1. How many kilometres of reticulated water are in the rural area within the borders of the Litchfield Council?
 2. Which roads have reticulated water?
 3. How many metres are there connected to water mains pipes – which then feed into private banjo lines?
 4. What is the current cost per kilometre to deliver water in the rural area where there is reticulated water?
 5. What work has been undertaken to develop further reticulated water in the rural area and what roads have been identified for conversion from bore water to reticulated water?
 6. What plans are in place to construct and develop water storage facilities to support a proposed development of Weddell?
 7. Has the Government undertaken any work on the future water infrastructure requirement for the rural area within the Litchfield Council boundaries?
 8. Has the Government done any work on supplying water to proposed development applications in the Noonamah locality and if so, what work and is it publically available?
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
