Mr Vowles to the Chief Minister:

Overseas Travel by Hon Willem Westra van Holthe

When did you first become aware the former Minister for Primary Industries and Fisheries:

- 1. Had conducted, or intended to conduct, discussions on private business matters with the CT group when travelling in Vietnam on official Government business?
- 2. Had conducted, or intended to conduct, discussions on private business matters with the CT group when travelling in Vietnam at his own expense?
- 3. What steps did you subsequently take to assure yourself that the Minister's discussions with CT Group in (1) and (2) above did not contravene:
 - (a) The Ministerial Code of Conduct?
 - (b) Any Northern Territory or Commonwealth statutes?
- 4. Will you ask the former Minister to repay all costs incurred on taxpayer funded trips to Vietnam during which he discussed private business matters with the CT group?

ANSWER

- 1. I had no knowledge of any private business matters being discussed with the CT group at that time.
- 2. As above.
- 3. Not applicable.

4. On each official trip the then Minister made he was on government business and undertook government business. When on personal leave I understand he paid his own fare. I am not aware of separate discussions on private business matters while on official business.

It was only on 11 March that I became aware the NT Police have concluded a preliminary Investigation into the allegations and advised that no further information or lawfully obtained evidence has been identified to support a reasonable belief that criminal conduct has occurred sufficient to enliven a criminal investigation case.
