

Question: Miscellaneous Permits

- 1. What are the terms and conditions of the Miscellaneous Permits issued concerning the removal of fill from the Jolly Street site.
- 2. What is the duration of the permit(s) relating to the Jolly Street site.
- 3. To whom is/are the permit(s) issued.
- 4. Are there any conditions attached to the permit(s); if so, what are they.
- 5. What were the conditions under which people could apply for fill from the Jolly Street site.
- 6. Have any other Miscellaneous Permits been issued concerning the removal of fill from any other site in the Darwin local area.

## **ANSWER**

- The terms and conditions of the Miscellaneous Licences issued for the removal of fill from the Jolly Street site are commercially confidential information between government and the licensee and as such I am not able to release the specific terms and conditions. Generally however, these provided for the removal of fill material to a pre-determined level in accordance with the environmental safeguards included in the Preliminary Environment Report prepared by the licensee.
- 2. The duration of Miscellaneous Licence No 1882 was for the period 31 December 1992 to 30 June 1993, while Miscellaneous Licence No 1819 was for the period 19 June 1992 to 30 December 1992.
- 3. Both licences were issued to Thiess Contractors Pty Ltd.
- 4. See answer to question 1.
- 5. To my knowledge the material removed was used as fill within the Cullen Bay Marina development.
- 6. The only other Miscellaneous Licence in the Darwin local area which remains current is the licence issued for removal of material from the Emery Point sandbar.
