Aboriginal Justice Unit staff

- 1. Under the AJU, how many FTE staff are employed, in what positions are they employed, and what is their salary?
- 2. Please provide the figues of the overall funding for the AJU and the implementation of the AJA, and please provide how much of the overall AJU funding goes towards staffing?

ANSWER

1. As at 30 June 2022, there were 10.94 FTE, 8.94 employed in the AJU, and two FTE funded by the AJU based in other divisions of the department, comprising the following:
