INQUIRY INTO THE DARWIN SHIP LIFT PROJECT CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

The Public Accounts Committee is calling for submissions to its inquiry into the Darwin Ship Lift Project. As set out in the referral from the Treasurer, the Hon Bill Yan MLA, the Committee is to inquire into the following:

Economic & Strategic Benefits

- Updated demand (defence, offshore energy, coastal shipping, super yachts, fishing).
- Direct/indirect jobs, supply chain impacts, skills development.

Contractual Commitments & Optimisation Options

- Key obligations and risk allocation in the executed agreements.
- Feasible design, staging or pricing refinements that do not breach current contracts.

Cost, Funding & Fiscal Exposure

- Capital and lifecycle cost including escalation and contingency.
- Funding sources (Territory, commonwealth programs such as NAIF).
- Ongoing budget impacts.

Governance & Project Control

Adequacy of oversight, probity and cost control processes.

Regulatory & Legislative Settings

Legislative and regulatory requirements.

Delivery Risks & Mitigation

- Construction, supply chain, workforce and inflationary risks.
- Interface with naval, port and land use planning.
- Contingency plans for cost or schedule overruns.

Opportunity Costs & Regional Impact

- Economic losses from past delays.
- Possible further action needed to fully realise the benefits.
