

TABLING NOTE FOR SUBORDINATE LEGISLATION
SUBORDINATE LEGISLATION NO. 8 OF 2017
CORPORATIONS LAW AMENDMENT RULES 2017

Purpose

The Corporations Law Amendment Rules 2017 provide for the amendment of the Corporations Law Rules by making a minor amendment to rule 2.6 to align the wording of 'Federal Court' with that anticipated to be inserted into the *Interpretation Act* by a future amendment.

The Corporations Law Amendment Rules 2017 were made by the Chief Justice and four other Judges of the Supreme Court, being a majority of the judges, in accordance with section 29 of the *Corporations Reform (Northern Territory) Act*.

Summary of key provisions

- Rule 2.6(c) is amended by omitting the words 'of Australia' from the reference to the Federal Court in that rule.

Legislative Authority
