Please provide us with the number of roads or total kilometres of roads that the government is responsible for?

**Answer:**

As at the 31 March 2017, the total number of kilometres of roads managed by local councils is 13 268 kilometres.

This figure can be further broken down as follows:

- 2 222 kilometers are sealed roads.
- 2 382 kilometers are gravel roads.
- 2 131 kilometers are formed roads.
- 6 316 kilometers are unformed roads.
- 217 kilometers are cycle paths.
