INDEPENDENT COMMISSIONER AGAINST CORRUPTION BILL

CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

The Social Policy Scrutiny Committee invites submissions to its inquiry into the Independent Commissioner Against Corruption (ICAC) Bill. The Committee encourages all interested people and organisations to provide their comments and feedback on the Bill.

In accordance with its terms of reference, the Committee is required to inquire into and report on:

- a) whether the Assembly should pass the Bill;
- b) whether the Assembly should amend the Bill;
- c) whether the Bill has sufficient regard to the rights and liberties of individuals; and
- d) whether the Bill has sufficient regard to the institution of Parliament.

Submissions to the Committee are due by close of business **Friday**, **29 September 2017** with public hearings to be held in Darwin on Monday, **9 October 2017**.
