Question:

Has the Minister received any reports of large amounts of soft coral and sponge being removed, or serious damage to the reef occurring as a result of bottom trawling?

Answer:

During the trial there has been no report of large scale interaction with coral habitat. Discussions with the observer from one of the initial trips indicated that the trawl net was fishing on the bottom but that this habitat was primarily sandy substrate. There have been subsequent improvements to the gear including the installation of additional flotation so that contact on the bottom is now very minimal. The trial has measures in place to minimise the interaction with coral habitat including: spatial closures over important coral habitat and move on provisions if the gear interacts with hard bottom.
