



2004 to 2007 (inclusive).

- The Territory has agreed to pay an Annual Fee of \$250,000 to the AFL to stage matches at Marrara Oval and Traeger Park and hold the camps in the Northern Territory from 2004 to 2006 (inclusive).

- Subject to the Agreement, AFL shall:

- schedule a Home and Away match at Marrara Oval to be played between the Western Bulldogs (or a replacement AFL Club to play 'home games' in the Northern Territory) and another AFL Club for the 2004, 2005 and 2006 Home and Away competition;

- schedule a pre-season match at Marrara Oval for the 2004, 2005 and 2006 pre-season competition;

- schedule a pre-season match at Traeger Park for the 2004, 2005 and 2006 pre-season competition;

- schedule Aboriginal All-Stars matches at Marrara Oval early 2005 and early 2007 prior to the commencement of these year's Home and Away competition; and

- hold a pre-season and mid-season camp over five days in the Northern Territory during 2004, 2005 and 2006.

- Personnel costs to the Department: 3 people x 10% for 2 months = \$2,800.

Total \$252,800

#### Commonwealth Bank Netball Trophy

- The Northern Territory paid Netball Australia a fee of \$47,500 to stage the match in the Northern Territory. The match was between the Queensland Firebirds and the AIS Canberra Darters on Friday 11 June 2004 in Darwin.

- The match coincided with the Northern Territory Netball Championships, which were also scheduled in Darwin over that weekend.

- As part of the Agreement between the Netball Australia and the Government, Netball was required conduct an Open Clinic at the Marrara Indoor Stadium in Darwin on 12 June 2004.

- Personnel costs to the Department: 4 people x 10% for 2 months = \$3,700.

Total \$51,200

## Hockey

- The Northern Territory Government agreed to pay a one-off grant of \$80,000 to the Northern Territory Hockey Association to host the International Hockey Pre-Olympic Women's Tournament in Darwin from 16-20 June 2004.

- The tournament was endorsed by the International Hockey Federation and will provide a final build up to the top twelve international women's hockey teams before the 2004 Olympic Games in Athens, Greece.

- Personnel costs to the Department: 4 people x 10% for 2 months = \$3,700.

Total \$83,700

## International Cricket

- The Event Agreement between the Northern Territory and Cricket Australia will see International Cricket staged at Marrara Oval from 2003 until 2007. There is an opportunity for Cricket Australia to conduct cricket matches at Marrara Oval in 2008 and beyond. Cricket Australia's intention to do so would need to be presented to the Territory by 31 December 2006.

- Prior to the staging of an International Cricket match a match between the visiting International team and the Chief Minister's XI will be staged. Three to four players of the Chief Minister's XI team will be from the Australian Team.

- The next Chief Ministers XI v Sri Lanka will be staged at Marrara Oval 24-27 June 2004.

- Personnel costs to the Department:  
3 people x 100% for 3 months = \$42,000  
1 person x 50% for 4 months = \$9300  
2 people x 20% for 3 months = \$5600  
1 person x 10% for 2 months = \$900  
Total = \$57,800
