Question: Please provide a specific and detailed breakdown of the 12% increase in non-oil exports since the commencement of the International Trade Strategy.

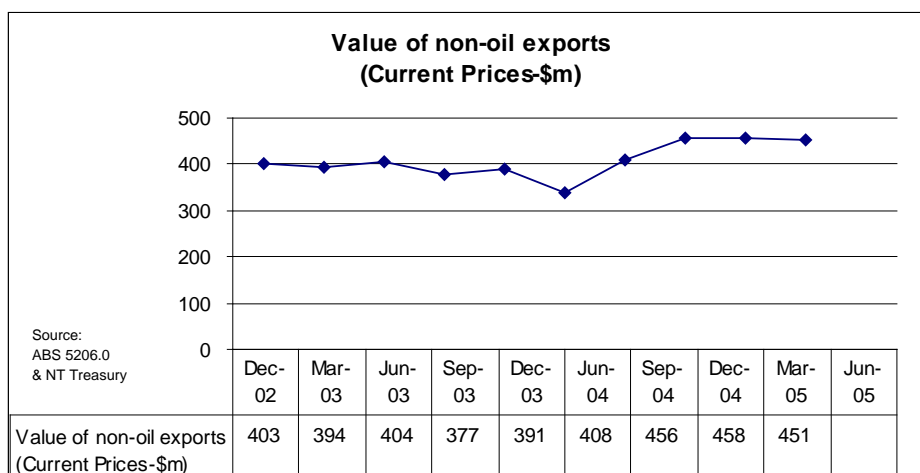

KEY POINTS:

Trade Objective 1: Lift the overall value and volume of Northern Territory non-oil exports by 40 percent.

- The value of non-oil exports has increased almost 12% since the commencement of the International Trade Strategy in January 2003.

Breakdown

The 12% increase in non-oil exports has been driven primarily by an increase in the value of metal ore exports (manganese and zinc) and to a lesser extent manufacturing exports.
