## Answer:

The Memorandum of Understanding between the Australian Government and the Northern Territory Government concludes on 30 June 2012. All agencies will be funded for the delivery of municipal and essential services for the 2011/12 financial year.

Funding amounts for 2011/12 will be consistent with funding allocated for the 2010/11 financial year, with two exceptions.

Funding will not be allocated to the Ramingining Homelands Resource Centre Aboriginal Corporation (RHRCAC) as the organisation has gone into liquidation, and Laynhapuy Homelands Association Incorporated (LHAI) has been granted a slight increase in its MUNS funding (municipal and essential services funding).
