Mr Guyula to the Minister for Health:

Renal ready rooms

- 1. Please advise what remote communities will receive the \$1.2 million in funding for renal ready rooms.
- 2. Please advise what research has been done in relation to the success of renal ready rooms in remote indigenous communities?

RESPONSE

- Pirlangimpi has been announced as the Top End community were a renal ready room will be established. Consultation with key stakeholders is currently underway to determine the preferred community in Central Australia with Mutitjulu the most likely location.
- Renal ready rooms are intended to give a client living on community a safe place to self-dialyse when they do not have a suitable space within their home. The number of people dialysing in remote communities is highly variable. Deteriorating health may require relocation to a major centre to access more comprehensive services.

Menzies School of Health Research is currently undertaking a NHMRC partnership research project on the different treatment models of renal care.
