Costs of Hotel Quarantining

The Minister told Budget Estimates Hearings that Northern Rise Village Services was providing services to the Howard Springs facility before it was used as a COVID Quarantine facility.

- 1. When exactly did Northern Rise Village Services commence providing a service to the Howard Springs facility?
- 2. When did the contract for Northern Rise Village Services to provide services to the Howard Springs centre commence, before it was repurposed to a COVID Quarantine Facility?
- 3. When precisely was Northern Rise Village Services first contracted by the NT Government to provide services to the Howard Springs quarantine facility?
- 4. What is the title of this contract or reference for this contract?
- 5. How was Northern Rise Village Services chosen for the contract to run the quarantine facility?
- 6. What were the original terms of contract between Northern Rise Village Services and the NT Government, for example services provided and the time frame?
- 7. How much of the \$24 million contract with the company has been spent to date?
- 8. From what Budget were the funds taken from to pay for this contract?
- 9. How much has the NT Government spent on hotels for quarantining people since the pandemic began (excluding the Mercure Hotel in Alice Springs)?

- 10. What is the break down for how much each hotel received from the NT Government to house quarantined people and the dates a particular hotel was used?
- 11. Under what circumstances were people sent to hotels instead of the Howard Springs or Alice Springs quarantine facility?
