### WRITTEN QUESTION

Mr Gunner to the Minister for Regional Development:

#### **Regional Development division of the Department of Regional Development and Indigenous Advancement as of 1 January 2013 – public servant numbers**

How many public servants were employed in the Regional Development division of the Department of Regional Development and Indigenous Advancement as of 1 January 2013 in the following categories:

- Full time or the equivalent;
  - Part time or the equivalent;
  - On temporary contracts;
  - At a lower classification than they were on 25 August 2012.
- 

The Regional Development portfolio has two divisions.

As at 1 January 2013, the number of public servants employed in the Regional Development division of the Department of Regional Development and Indigenous Advancement was as follows:

- 22.75 full time or the equivalent;
- No part time employees;
- 6 on temporary contracts; and
- No employees at a lower classification than they were on 25 August 2012.

As at 1 January 2013, the number of public servants employed in the Regional Services division of the Department of Regional Development and Indigenous Advancement was as follows:

- 20 full time or the equivalent;
- 1 part time employee;
- 8 on temporary contracts; and
- No employees at a lower classification than they were on 25 August 2012.
