22. Road Construction Costs associated with the Cannonball Run

QUESTION

1. Was the wider section of the road, at the site of the fatal accident during the Cannonball Run, specifically constructed for the Cannonball Run as a stopping zone or lay-by; if so, what was the cost of the construction of this area of the road.
2. Were any other road constructions undertaken specifically for the Cannonball Run; if so:
 - (a) what were they; and
 - (b) what was the cost of each construction.
