Question: Hybrid Diesel/Battery Power Stations

1. How many hybrid diesel/battery power stations of the type installed at Wilora (Stirling) have been installed in the Territory.
2. Where are these power stations located.
3. At each location, is the unit owned by or leased to the government.
4. Where the unit is leased, what is the annual cost of the lease.
5. What is the cost per kilowatt hour of electricity produced in each location, including lease costs where applicable.

ANSWER

1. 5.
2. Stirling (Wilora); Murray Downs; Utopia Station; Alcoota (Engawala); and Litchfield Park.
3. Leased.
4. \$85 067.04 per unit per annum for the 2 units leased to the Power and Water Authority. Remaining units are leased to the Conservation Commission (Litchfield Park) and the Department of Education (Murray Downs and Utopia Station).
5. Stirling - \$3.50 per kilowatt hour; Alcoota - \$2.90 per kilowatt hour (includes fuel, operation and maintenance and lease charges).
