ANSWER

- 1. Four were settled. The normal practice is for the terms of settlement to contain a non-disclosure clause.
- 2. Major cost items in the operational subsidy between 1986-87 and 1991-92 are legal expenses associated with Aboriginal land claims, BTEC, fencing and land survey costs.
