

Question: Katherine Hospital Budget and Staffing

- 1. Does the Katherine Hospital have a Mission Statement and a Corporate Plan; if so, what are they.
- What was the total cost of purchases made by the Katherine Hospital, or the Department of Health and Community Services on behalf of the Katherine Hospital, from Modular Medical Products and Territory Surgical Supplies in the following financial years -
  - (a) 1990-91; and
  - (b) 1991-92.
- Were the purchases referred to in question 2 for medical supplies or medical equipment; how much was spent on each category.
- Has the Katherine Hospital been refused access to the Royal Darwin Hospital for the transfer of patients in the following financial years -
  - (a) 1991-92; and
  - (b) 1992-93 to date.
- 5. Have any elective surgery deferrals at the Katherine Hospital been made; if so, how many have occurred and what was the reason in each case.
- 6. How many staff are employed at the Katherine Hospital; what are the position titles and Northern Territory Public Service classifications for each of these positions.
- 7. How many -
  - (a) nurses; and
  - (b) enrolled nurses,

have resigned from the Katherine Hospital in the following financial years -

- (i) 1990-91;
- (ii) 1991-92; and

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- (iii) 1992-93 to date.
- 8. What is the figure in answer to question 7 as a percentage of the total number of staff in each area.
- 9. What was the final decision regarding laundry services at Katherine Hospital.
