Remote Health Clinic Closures

1. How many remote health clinics were either temporarily or permanently closed from 24 December 2021 throughout the Northern Territory?

Top End, Big River and East Arnhem Regional NTG-serviced remote health clinics remained open during the Christmas-New Year holiday period. Some clinics offered reduced services over the recognised public holidays.

In the Central Australia and Barkly regions, there were 8 health NTGserviced remote health clinics that were temporarily closed or on reduced services. Emergency services were on call to cover health centres that were closed during the Christmas-New Year period.
