Mr Yan to the Minister for Health:

## **Ambulances at Royal Darwin Hospital**

1. What is the average time a patient waits in an ambulance upon arrival at Royal Darwin Hospital before the patient enters the hospital?

From the time St John NT ambulance crew arrive at the hospital until the patient care is taken over by the hospital staff is on average, 36 minutes.

2. In the 2021/22 financial year, how many patients who arrived at Royal Darwin Hospital in an ambulance were brought directly to an Emergency Department bed?

In 2021-22 financial year 26,244 patients were transported to RDH Emergency department.

3. In the 2021/22 financial year, how many patients who arrived at Royal Darwin Hospital in an ambulance were admitted immediately?

Patients arriving by ambulance need emergency care and are admitted via the Emergency Department.

4. In the 2021/22 financial year, how many patients who arrived at Royal Darwin Hospital in an ambulance were brought to the Emergency Department waiting room to wait there?

All patients who arrive by ambulance are assessed by a triage nurse and if it is clinically appropriate they will be placed in the waiting room. Data is not collected on this scenario.
