 The 2018/19 Transforming Out of Home Care report stated that: "Purchased home-based care will be phased-out in preference for family/kin and foster care".

The 2018/19 report showed that there were 347 in purchased home-based care and Written Question 348 states in July 2022 there werre 361 children in purchased home-based care.

How many children are in purchased home-based care today? What is the total cost of their care per day?

- 2. How many children are in kinship care?
- 3. How many children are in foster care?
- 4. From the 23/24 budget, how much funding will go to providing purchased home-based care? And how much funding will go to foster care services and how much funding will go to kinship care services?
- 5. Could you provide an estimate of how much a kinship carer recieves and a foster carer receives per child compared with the cost associated with purchased home based care per child?

I realise each case is different depending on the needs of the child - please provide an approximate comparison based on the average?
