Subject: People picked up by police

QUESTION:

For the whole of the Northern Territory, how many times have the police picked someone up and taken them to a watch house, home, sobering up shelter, rehabilitation facility, hospital or other?

ANSWER:

Within the Northern Territory:

1,929 persons were taken to watch houses;

1,733 persons were conveyed to their home residence;

3,357 persons were conveyed to sobering up shelters; and

471 persons were conveyed to hospitals and/or clinics.
