Subject: Police station at Alpurrurulam

## **QUESTION**

The objective is to have minimal crime and adequate policing. Why is there no police station at Alpurrurulam?

## **ANSWER**

The construction of a new police complex at Alpurrurulam is included in the Northern Territory Government NT Infrastructure Plan and Pipeline for 2026, which includes a new Police Station, housing and visiting officer quarters.

Service delivery for Alpurrurulam is currently managed by the Avon Downs Police Station, located within the Tennant Creek and Barkly Division.

Alpurrurulam has a 24/7 all-weather bitumen airstrip which affords air wing police surge capacity access should the situation necessitate.

There are ten Queensland Police officers also sworn in under the Special Constable provisions of the NT *Police Administration Act 1978* with Camooweal Police Station located approximately 172km from Alpurrurulam.
