Youth Detention

Please provide the following data for the 12 months to 30 September 2023:

- 1. How many youths entered a detention centre who were:
 - a. Less than 12 years old at the time of admission?
 - b. 12 years or older at the time of admission?

ANSWER:

From 12 January 2023 to 11 January 2024 a total of 288 individual young people entered detention.

This includes 4 young people under the age of 12 at the time of reception prior the Northern Territory Government raising the minimum age of criminal responsibility on 1 August 2023.

- 2. Of the youths who entered a detention centre who were less than 12 years old, how many were:
 - a. On remand?
 - b. Convicted and on a sentenced period of detention?

ANSWER:

The legal status at the time of entry for these individuals cannot be reported. However, the majority of young people in NT detention facilities are on remand.
