QUESTION:

How long were the delays in relation to new builds as a result of crime?

ANSWER:

Between 1 July 2023 and 31 March 2024, 54 business days were lost by contractors undertaking new house builds in remote communities as a result of crime.

Despite this, the Northern Territory Government met all of its delivery obligations under the jointly funded Federation Funding Agreement on Northern Territory Remote Housing and had its second largest year on record in the delivery of new homes throughout the Northern Territory.
