Advise the status of the gifted program at Moil Primary School, the budget allocation for the program in 2014-15, and whether it will be disbanded

**ANSWER:**

*School band decision*

This year the school has restructured the program from being a single class to a program with a focus on reading and mathematics. 30 students now benefit from the program, a substantial increase.

Moil Primary receives <sup>1 teacher</sup> an out of model full time equivalent teacher to staff the Gifted program. No additional grant is allocated to support this program.

With the move to global budgets, schools will be able to determine their staffing composition and allocate resources accordingly. Moil Primary School will need to determine if the gifted program continues in 2015.
