My Key Priorities for Alice Springs (2016 - 2020)

- Ensure Alice Springs remains a top priority for the NT Government
- Plan for a new Alice Springs Hospital for 2030
- Continue to reduce crime, anti-social behaviour and the impact of alcohol abuse on our community.
- The establishment of a purpose built, specialised Palliative Care Hostel in Alice Springs
- Deliver night time youth services 7 nights per week
- Strengthen School Councils to ensure our public schools get the best deal from Government for our kids
- Support for Alice Springs continuing as a leading centre for solar energy generation and innovation
- Advocate for major infrastructure projects for Alice Springs:
 - Rail overpass on the Larapinta / Stuart Highway intersection
 - A new high-level Bridge over the Todd River replacing the Tuncks Road Crossing or the Taffy Pick Crossing
 - Full upgrade of the Todd Mall
 - Upgrade of the Flynn Drive Community Health Centre
 - Upgrade of the Alice Springs Women's Shelter
- Support a moratorium on horizontal fracturing or "fracking" until the community is broadly satisfied it is not a threat to our water supply and our public health in Alice Springs.
- Better support for true "local" businesses in the Government procurement and tender process
- Establish a National Centre for the research, treatment and prevention of Foetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) in Alice Springs, together with a preventative service for women at risk.
- Deliver more public housing and the better maintenance and regulation of existing public housing
- Develop and implement a Master Plan for sport in Alice Springs
- Ensure Government continues to provide assistance to First Home Owners
- The funding of a new water supply for the Alice Springs Golf Club to address the serious, long term salinity problem.
- The establishment of a peak body for Domestic Violence Services in the NT, the head office based in Alice Springs.
