For Elizabeth Fullerton:

- The daily counsel rate was \$4,950.00;
- The total amount paid in relation to the prosecution was \$45,912.64; and
- The amount paid for airfares, accommodation and incidentals would have been included in the De Silva Hebron disbursements of \$14,867.52 and is estimated to be approximately \$5,000.00.
