Answer: The investigation of establishing an oil and gas institute was first discussed

during the 2001 election campaign. Following further discussion with industry after the election, it was advised that there was no pressing need

for such a facility at the time.

The Department of Employment, Education and Training facilitated meetings between ConocoPhillips and Charles Darwin University to discuss possible training needs. They also arranged for discussion to take place with interstate training providers specialising in the oil and gas sector, including Challenger TAFE Institute in Western Australia.

The Department continues to work with the peak industry association, Australian Petroleum, Production and Exploration Association, and

ConocoPhillips on future training needs.
