Note

The above figures have been taken as a snapshot from Pay 26 of each year (last pay period in June). Staffing figures fluctuate according to staff turnover, recruitment drives and restructures.

The figures for Sports House are an estimate based on structure codes. These codes do not specify location, but rather a unit or program. Employee names have been looked at in an effort to be as accurate as possible.

Events Branch, responsible for the running of the Arafura & Masters Games, moved to the Department of the Chief Minister, NT Major Events Company P/L co-locating the games with other major initiatives such as the V8 cars and Bass in the Grass, in late 2006.

Management of Hidden Valley Complex returned to Sport and Recreation in 2006/07.

January 2007 Water Safety & Animal Welfare staff began reporting to Executive Director Sport and Recreation, administrative date of 1 July 2007 23 employees and 26 positions were transferred to Sport and Recreation.

The Indigenous Sports Program is funded externally with the Australian Government funding, usually on a two-year temporary contract and employs 8 staff.
