Mr Gunner: What have been the changes in all NT Government grant programs from the last budget 2012-2013 to this budget 2013-2014, and where they have been reduced to zero, what were they and how many of them?

ANSWER:

The Department of Education and Children's Services grants program budget increased by \$9 million, from \$260 million in 2012-13 to \$269 million in 2013-14.

There is one grant program discontinuing in 2013-14, detailed below:

Title	Movement Between 2012-13 and 2013-14 \$ 000	Purpose
Polly Farmer in Central Australia	-159	Grant in support of program based at Centralian Senior Secondary College providing support to Indigenous youth to achieve their potential. This program ceased 30 June 2013 and students continue to receive support through a range of alternative programs.
