How many wildlife management plans were developed and implemented in the year, which we have heard, but what was the cost of developing each of those management plans?

Answer: In 2008-09, there were five Wildlife Management Plans: Magpie Goose (being reviewed); Saltwater Crocodile (being reviewed); Freshwater Crocodile (new); Dingo (finalised); and Cycad (being reviewed). The 2008-09 estimated costs for preparing these plans is \$250,000.
