- a) **Question:** How does \$280 000 achieve in terms of the remote electorate education program?

Answer: The funding enables the NTEC to undertake remote activities associated to ensuring roll quality is maintained, electors are educated in enrolling and voting processes and Communities are made aware of their election ready preparedness and confidence for the actual voting in August 2020.
