Mr Higgins for the Minister for Local Government, Housing and Community Development:

Homelands

- 1. How many jobs have been created and maintained under the \$6 million Homelands Jobs program? In which communities?
 - In 2018-19, the Homelands Jobs program provided grant funding to service providers for the employment of 145 local Aboriginal employees in the delivery of services in homelands and town camps.
- 2. How many houses/dwellings do you estimate are needed currently in the Territory's homelands?
 - In 2018-19, grant funding for the delivery of homelands services for 1464 homes in 383 homelands.
 - The 2016 Homelands and Outstations Assets and Access Review (HOAAR) findings indicate that approximately 1600 homes are required in funded Northern Territory homelands to provide for a housing occupancy rate of two persons per bedroom.
- 3. How many new houses have been provided by the Territory Government to homelands since March 2018 and where?
 - The existing Northern Territory Homelands Policy does not provide for the funding of new homes on homelands.
- 4. Please provide an update on the Government's work on its aim to implement 40 year leases for homelands and outstations.
 - There is no policy commitment relating to the introduction of 40 year leases on homelands.
