## **Home Building Certification Fund**

- 1. What is the current balance of the Home Building Certification Fund.
- 2. For the Fund financial year 1998/99 -
  - (a) how much was deposited into the fund;
  - (b) how many claims were made against the fund;
  - (c) of the claims made, how many were successful and what are the details of the amount paid for each claim;
  - (d) how much was spent advertising the fund; and
  - (e) where and how was the fund advertised to consumers.

## **ANSWER**

- 1. Fund balance as at 30 June 1999 is \$2,429,535.31
- 2. For the financial year 1998/99:
  - (a) \$861,850 was deposited;
  - (b) 44 claims were made against the fund;
  - (c) 29 claims were successful incurring a total cost of \$236,652.86 (individual claim details attached);
  - (d) no money was spent advertising the fund;
  - (e) brochures are available from TIO and consumers are advised of the requirement as part of the building approval process.
