Ms Walker to the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice:

**Public Servant Numbers – Department of the Attorney-General and Justice<sup>1</sup>**

1. Would you please advise how many public servants<sup>2</sup> were employed;

- Full time or the equivalent – 427.7 FTE
- Part time or the equivalent – 21.97<sup>3</sup>FTE
- On temporary contracts – 193.58<sup>4</sup>FTE

in the Department of Attorney-General and Justice on 24 August 2012.

2. Would you please advise how many public servants are employed -

- Full time or the equivalent – 418.09 FTE
- Part time or the equivalent – 18.29 FTE
- On temporary contracts – 173.73

in the Department of Attorney-General and Justice on 31 October 2012.<sup>5</sup>
