68. Government Cost Agreements regardingLegal Action Manzie v Northern Territory News

## Mr. BELL to MINISTER for CHIEF MINISTER

## QUESTION

1. Has the Northern Territory Government concluded a cost agreement with the plaintiff in respect of the legal action involving Manzie v *Northern Territory News*.

If the answer to question 1 is yes:

- 2. Under which statutory provision does the Chief Minister purport to make payments under the cost agreement to Mr Manzie.
- 3. How was the conflict of interest in relation to Mr Manzie resolved with respect to the cost agreement concluded between himself and the Cabinet in which he is a Minister.
- 4. Will the Chief Minister table any such cost agreement; if not, why not.
- 5. Is the cost agreement referred to in question 4 in the same terms as that concluded with Dennis Hart.
- 6. Has the Northern Territory Government paid any monies on this agreement to date; if so, how much.
- 7. If the answer to question 6 is yes, to whom were those monies paid to under the agreement.

#### ANSWER

#### Answered on 27/02/96

- 1. The Northern Territory Government authorised indemnity of the plaintiff's legal costs.
- 2. The Crown's inherent right to represent a Minister of the Crown.
- 3. Mr Manzie was excluded from Cabinet deliberations on this matter.

- 4. No. Cabinet decisions are privileged.
- 5. No. Dennis Hart was not and is not a Minister of the Crown.
