104. **Parliament House Lighting**

Mr. BAILEY to MINISTER for TRANSPORT and WORKS

QUESTION

1. In respect of each of the custom manufactured lighting items scheduled below, what is
 - (a) the number of lighting items installed; and
 - (b) the contracted costs for the:
 - (i) supply;
 - (ii) installation; and, if separate figures are not available,
 - (iii) the total costs for supply and installation.
2. Has 100% of the contract amount been paid; if not, what amount remains unpaid to the respective contractors.

This detailed information of a breakdown of individual items is not kept by Government. Steps have been taken to obtain this information from the electrical engineering consultant and cost consultant through the Project Manager, Tipperary Developments. As Tipperary Developments no longer reside in Darwin, the supply of this information may take longer than normal. I will endeavour to obtain this information as soon as possible.
2. An agreement for full and final settlement of the electrical services sub-contractor with Jet Electrics was reached and the agreed sum of money paid to Jet Electrics, through Tipperary Developments and Multiplex.
