### QUESTION:

Of the 60 assaults on police that have resulted in prison time for the offender, how many of those were to the rising of the court?

How many were for time served on remand?

And how many served time, not on remand, in either the Darwin Correctional Centre or the Alice Springs Correctional facility or the Tennant Creek work camp?

### ANSWER:

There were 48 cases/defendants and 47 distinct individual offenders. None of those were to the rising of the court. Seven were released forthwith for time served on remand.
