Subject: Key property offences

QUESTION:

The review of the penalties for property offences in the criminal code was to be conducted in two tranches, with the first review of the first tranche of key property offences. What is meant by the term 'key property offences'?

ANSWER:

The review undertaken as part of Tranche 1 of the review of property offences in Part VII of the Criminal Code included the following offences:

- Stealing (section 210 Criminal Code)
- Unlawful entry of buildings (section 213)
- Robbery (section 211)
- Persons found armed with intent to unlawfully enter buildings (section 215)
- Removal of things from places open to the public (section 219)
- Receiving stolen property (section 229)
