Subject: Assaults on Correctional staff

QUESTION:

How many assaults on Correctional officers or other Corrections staff have there been for the current financial year across all prisons? Can you provide a breakdown between prisons? Of the numbers of assaults which one resulted in an injury to the officer—those that involved spitting or other bodily fluids and those that involved weapons?

ANSWER:

For the financial year 2020-21 (as at 31 March 2021), there were a total of 31 assaults on correctional staff, as categorised below:

Weapon Used	0	1	1
Injury	2	9	11
Spitting	2	5	7
Nil Injury	6	6	12
TOTAL	10	21	31

Note: Injury - victim subjected to physical violence that resulted in physical injuries but did not require overnight hospitalisation or on-going medical treatment.

Nil Injury - victim subjected to physical violence that did not result in physical injuries or require any form of medical treatment.
